Welcome to Viviross City's Privacy Policy Citizen!

We, at Viviross City believe that privacy means a lot to our Users – that is why we made every effort to create a service that would live up to such user privacy standards we ourselves would be comfortable with.

This Privacy Policy forms an inseparable part of our Terms of Service, located at www.viviross.city, www.vivirosscredit.city; Capitalized terms used but not otherwise defined in this Privacy Policy shall have the meaning given to them in the Terms of Service.

We strongly encourage you to read this Privacy Policy and make sure you fully understand and agree with it, prior to your access or use of any of our Services. If you do not fully understand or agree to this Privacy Policy, you must immediately leave this website and avoid all use of any of our Services.

Background

When you use our Services, you explicitly consent to the collection, use and disclosure of your information as described in this Privacy Policy, as well as to Cookies being stored and set and information being accessed on your equipment.

We know that you care how information about you is used and shared.

This Privacy Policy explains what information of yours will be collected by us and stored on our servers when you make use of the Services and how the information will be used.

WE WILL NOT USE OR SHARE YOUR INFORMATION WITH ANYONE EXCEPT AS DESCRIBED IN THIS PRIVACY POLICY OR OUR TERMS OF SERVICE.

This Privacy Policy may be updated from time to time and therefore we ask you to check back periodically for the most updated form of Privacy Policy (as indicated at the top of this page). Your continued use of our Services after this Privacy Policy has been updated shall be deemed as your continued acceptance of the terms of this Privacy Policy, as updated and revised from time to time.

What Information Do We Collect and How?

Personal Information

We may collect and store any information you *explicitly* provide or enable us to access, whether via the Services, the device through which our Services are accessed, 3rd Party Login Services and 3rd Party Accounts, or direct communication (for example, in the process of registration to the Website services, filling forms or submitting enquiries), including information which identifies or relates to you personally, in addition, such information may

include information that when aggregated, might be used jointly to identify any of our Users ("**Personal Information**").

For example:

- When connecting to us through 3rd Party Login Services, such as Facebook Connect, you may be allowing us access to your contact information, name, gender, location, photographs, list of friends and groups of which you are a member.

Based on the settings of your device and should you specifically allow, you may be sharing with us your location, photographs and contacts.

Non-Personal Information

We collect and aggregate non-identifying information regarding your use of our Services, including, for example, the type, model, ID and location of the device through which the Services are accessed, pages browsed, search inquiries, services that interested you or which you have utilized, the type of operating system and browser you are using and its settings, your IP address, the URL you have come from and the time spent at that URL, content of Cookies set by us (as further detailed below) and your domain type and server ("**Non-Personal Information**").

Note that Non-Personal Information may be aggregated separately for each specific IP or device ID. That said, the ID of your device does not contain any information regarding your identity and the same applies to IP addresses which, while identifying a device connected to the Internet and its general location, are in themselves anonymous and contain no information regarding the identity of the ultimate person using the device – such identity should be known solely to your ISP.

Moreover, IP addresses assigned by ISPs are generally (although not always) dynamic and subject to frequent change – static IP addresses are generally assigned only at subscriber's specific request and frequently require an additional fee.

How Is Collected Information Used?

Personal Information

Personal Information shall be used solely in order to facilitate and improve the Services, process your inquiries and respond to your requests, or as explicitly mentioned herein.

For example, Personal Information submitted for presentation in the course of the Services, may be presented to other Users.

We may share some or all of your Personal Information with our subsidiaries, joint ventures or other companies under a common control that we have or may have in the future, providing such party undertakes to protect your privacy in accordance with these terms.

We may also share some or all of your Personal Information with third parties assisting us with respect to the Services (including 3rd party analytic sites) subject to any such party protecting your privacy in accordance with these terms.

Otherwise, we will not disclose your Personal Information to any third party, unless:

- Required to do so as part of any legal proceedings conducted between you and us.
- Required to do so by court order.
- In case the entire activity of the Website is transferred to a third party, providing such party undertakes to protect your privacy in accordance with these terms.

Non-Personal Information

Non-Personal Information shall be used to ensure the adequate operation, improve, modify, cancel, enrich or adjust the Website, in general or to your area of interest.

We reserve the right to use and disclose Non-Personal Information (in the form collected) to third parties, including, for example, potential and actual business partners, affiliates and consultants, at our sole discretion.

Why Do We Collect Such Information?

We collect Such Personal Information and Non-Personal Information for the following purposes:

1. In order to provide and operate the Services, alongside improve and customize them, based on Users' preferences and experiences.
2. In order to be able to provide our Users with ongoing, developing customer assistance and technical support.
3. In order to create statistical data which we or our business partners may use to provide and improve our respective services.
4. In order to remain in compliance with and applicable law or regulations.
5. In order to investigate, prevent or take action regarding illegal activities, suspected fraudulent behavior, potential threats or any other violations of our Terms of Service and Privacy Policy.

How Do We Keep Your Personal Information Secure?

We do so by following industry standards on information security management to secure sensitive information such as financial information and Personal Information entrusted to us.

Cookies

What are Cookies?

Cookies are small data files downloaded and stored on user's device while browsing a website, often used to keep record of actions taken on such website or track related browsing activity.

Disabling the use of Cookies

Such parties may use Cookies placed on your device (as well as web beacons and other similar technologies) in order to adjust or track the content presented through the Services.

Regarding use of Cookies by third-party content companies, please note that such use is subject to the privacy policy of said parties and is not subject to these terms (for example, regarding advertisements served by Google, see <http://www.google.com/privacy/ads>).

Information Security

Note that although we take measures to secure the information and reduce the risk of unwanted disclosure, we cannot guarantee the information will not be exposed as a result of unauthorized penetration to our servers.
